SHE GRADUATED FROM COLLEGE AND MARRIED JOHN FIELDS IN 1984. HER SON WAS BORN IN 1986. LEDA AND JOHN THEN MOVED TO CALIFORNIA IN 1987 AND HAD A DAUGHTER IN 1988.

BEFORE COMING TO CALIFORNIA, SHE AND HER HUSBAND HAD JOINED THE WAUKEGAN BRIDGE CLUB WHERE THEY TOOK LESSONS. LEDA HAD ALSO TAUGHT SPANISH, BUT ONCE IN CALIFORNIA, HER TWO SMALL CHILDREN TOOK UP MOST OF HER TIME.

VERY HOME AND FAMILY-ORIENTED, LEDA OFTEN PLAYS IN TOURNAMENTS WITH HER HUSBAND AND SON. IN JUNE, 2013, PLAYINGWITH HER SON IN LAS VEGAS, SHE BECAME A LIFE MASTER.
